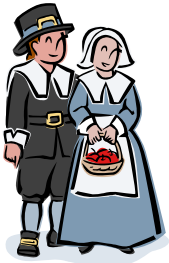

## Home Reading Reading

For November, the students will bring home a picture of a turkey. They can color one section each time they read for 10 or 15 minutes. Please return by the end of November.

We learn a new group of words almost every week, so please review those word lists every night.

This month we're working on short vowels **o**, **e**, and **u**. asking sentences and telling sentences (? and .), words with l-blends (such as bl and cl), and telling story events in sequence.

\*Reading and writing go hand in hand. Ask your child to write at home, sounding out the words.

If you're busy cooking, ask your child to write an item on the grocery list, sounding it out the best he/she can. Your child can write notes reminding you of things to do, or he/she can write thank you notes to grandparents.

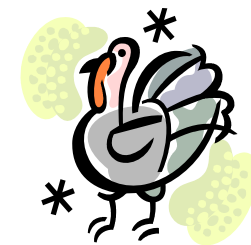
## Social Studies
